

concur.

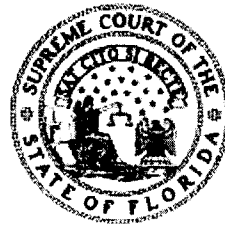
