The report of the referee regarding the findings of fact and recommendations of guilt are approved. The Court further agrees that a rehabilitative suspension is appropriate as well as a mental health evaluation by a mental health professional, approved by Florida Lawyers, Assistance, Inc. However, in light of the serious rule violations, the Court concludes that a suspension of six months is the appropriate length of suspension.

Accordingly, the respondent is suspended from the practice of law for six months, effective thirty days from the date of this order so that respondent can close out her practice and protect the interests of existing clients. If respondent notifies this Court in writing that she is no longer practicing and does not need the thirty days to protect existing clients, this Court will enter an order making the suspension effective immediately. Respondent shall fully comply with Rule Regulating the Florida Bar 3-5.1(h). In addition, respondent shall accept no new business from the date this order is filed until she is reinstated by order of this Court.

Respondent is directed to comply with all other terms and conditions of the report of referee. Further, respondent shall participate in any treatment recommended as a result of the mental health evaluation.

Judgment is entered for The Florida Bar, 651 East Jefferson Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2300, for recovery of costs from Marie Louise Henry in the amount of \$5,595.45, for which sum let execution issue.

Not final until time expires to file motion for rehearing, and if filed, determined. The filing of a motion for rehearing shall not alter the effective date of this suspension.
