IT IS ORDERED that The Florida Bar's petition is granted and respondent is held in contempt of this Court's order, dated September 29, 2016, in Case No. SC16-1227. As a sanction, respondent is suspended from the practice of law for one year. Respondent is currently suspended; therefore this suspension is effective immediately. Respondent shall fully comply with Rule Regulating the Florida Bar 3-5.1(h). Respondent is further directed to comply with the terms of the Court's order in SC16-1227 prior to petitioning for reinstatement.

Judgment is entered for The Florida Bar, 651 East Jefferson Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2300, for recovery of costs from Gregg R. Lopez in the amount of \$1,250.00, for which sum let execution issue.

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
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Not final until time expires to file motion for rehearing, and if filed, determined. The filing of a motion for rehearing shall not alter the effective date of this suspension.
