



HEALTH LAW CERTIFICATION EXAMINATION FORMAT & SCORING



1. Examination Format

The Health law examination is administered in two parts:

Part I consists of:

- 56 multiple choice questions on various topics as outlined in “Examination Content,” each worth 1.75 points, for a total of 98 points.
- One essay question on the topic of Fraud and Abuse, worth 66 points.

Part II consists of:

- One essay question on the topic of Provider Regulation, worth 54 points.
- One essay question on the topic of Institutional Operations and Patient Care, worth 54 points.
- One essay question on the topic of Integration and Reimbursement, worth 54 points.

The Health law exam is worth a total of 326 possible points. A passing score is 70% (228 points) or higher.

2. Scoring

Essays are graded on a holistic scale of 1-6, and then multiplied by 11 (Fraud and Abuse essay) or 9 (all other essays) for a total essay score.
